Reviewing Professional Boundaries

Let's review some very important ways that CAREGivers can keep professional boundaries. Professional Boundaries protect the CAREGiver and client from forming unhealthy codependent relationships.

- Don't Share Personal Information: This includes last names and phone numbers
 Don't React Emotionally to Client Behaviors
- Don't Use Nicknames or Endearments: Address clients by the name they tell you to
- Don't Accept Gifts or Offer Special Favors: If you are offered a gift, contact the office
 - Don't Visit with Clients during Unscheduled Times
 - Don't Keep Secrets for the Client
- Keep Your Demearnor Professional: This includes the way you dress, the things you say, the way you speak, and hygiene
- Follow HIPAA Guidelines: Do not discuss the client with anyone outside of the Home Instead office
 - Be Aware of Under/Over Involvement

- Home Repairs




RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Sour Cream Cheesy Baked Chicken By: Chrystal R

Ingredients
6-8 Chicken Breasts
4 TBS Butter
8 oz Sour Cream
1 Bag of shredded cheese
Salt & Pepper
Lemon Juice (optional)

Directions

Melt 4 TBS of butter and pour half into a cake pan. Place chicken in cakepan on top of melted butter. Pour the rest of the butter on the chicken. Cover chicken with sour cream. Season with salt and pepper and lemon if desired. Top with bag of shredded cheese. Cover with foil and place in oven set at 350 degrees for 3 hours. After 3 hours, remove the chicken and let sit for 45 minutes. Baste the chicken with the broth in the pan. Place back in the over at 250 degrees for 1 hour or until the internal temperature reaches 165 degrees. Let cool before serving.
